## CAMO for lessors and banks

**Ownership, possession and management of aircraft assets entail the fulfilment of numerous legal requirements. With its CAMO (Continuing Airworthiness Management Organization) team Lufthansa Technik is able to offer services supporting non-commercial aircraft owners such as lessors, banks and insurance companies in meeting these requirements.**



### Meeting legal requirements

To smoothen the process of aircraft transitions from one operator to the next and the work associated with this process, Lufthansa Technik offers services tailored specifically to the unique requirements of lessors and banks.

Certified as a Continuing Airworthiness Management Organization, Lufthansa Technik's CAMO team is approved to provide comprehensive services relating to airworthiness management and reviews.

### CAMO services

Lufthansa Technik offers a progressive range of services for lessors and banks. The standard portfolio covers the basic requirements. Beginning with airworthiness reviews – approved staff from Lufthansa Technik is authorized to perform such reviews – the services comprise the development and certification of an Airworthiness Directive (AD) status or complete Aircraft Maintenance Programs (AMP), the tracing of Time Controlled Components up to taking on the full responsibility for the management of continuing airworthiness.

### Much more than basics

Complementing the basic CAMO package, Lufthansa Technik offers a host of services. Ferry flights, check flights and acceptance flights for example are performed according to the approved Check Flight Manual. For this kind of demanding task, the CAMO team uses pilots specially trained and approved for such flights. Aircraft with structural damages or overdue Airworthiness Directives (AD) are flown in accordance with Lufthansa Technik's approved Special Flight Conditions under an EASA Permit to Fly.

Having the aircraft handled by Lufthansa Technik – from ferry flights to complex transitions – maximizes the utilization of the customer's asset. All airworthiness requirements can also be contracted to Lufthansa Technik's CAMO.

### Cooperating with authorities

The CAMO team is also able to issue a Certificate of Airworthiness (CofA) for Export in combination with a temporary German registration mark. This process greatly eases handling of an aircraft, at the same time offering taxation advantages. Aircraft parking and storage is also available, with Lufthansa Technik assuming the function of an interim operator including the responsibility for the condition of the aircraft. And finally, an EASA Part 145 Release to Service in combination with a temporary German registration mark can be issued.
