Lufthansa Technic AG Approval to Perform Maintenance on Brunei Registered Aircraft

Reference is made to your Letter, dated 15 January 2015, requesting cancellation of your Brunei Department of Civil Aviation, Part 145 Approval Reference, DCA.145-021, and the granting of approval to perform maintenance on Brunei registered aircraft using your EASA Part 145, Approval Reference DE.145.0001.

Having investigated this request, the approval of Lufthansa Technic Ag to issue certificates of release to service to certify maintenance on Brunei Registered aircraft, under the terms of EASA Part Approval, Reference DE.145.0001, is agreed, in accordance with Brunei Civil Aviation Regulations 2006, Regulation 12(2), and subject to the following conditions:

- i. The approval is only valid while Lufthansa Technic AG, EASA 145 Approval, remains valid and in accordance with the requirements of that approval.
- ii. Valid only for the work performed on aircraft on the Brunei Register
- iii. The work on Brunei registered aircraft is performed in accordance with LHT, IQ MOVE, Supplement 9, Issue 9 or any future issue approved by the DCA.
- iv. Subject to compliance with the foregoing conditions, this approval shall remain valid unless the approval has previously/ been surrendered, superseded, suspended or revoked

In addition to parts released in accordance with your EASA Part 145 Approval, Parts released on a Brunei DCA Form 1 can be installed by Lufthansa Technic AG on Brunei Registered aircraft under the terms of this approval and in accordance with LHT, IQ MOVE, Supplement Number 9.


For the avoidance of doubt, references in this letter to a "certificate of release to service" means a certificate of release to service issued in accordance with the Brunei Civil Aviation Regulations 2006, Regulation 10(4), this requirement is included below for reference;

"10. (4) A certificate of release to service shall —

- (a) certify that the aircraft or any part thereof or its equipment has been overhauled, repaired, replaced, modified or maintained, as the case may be, in a manner and with material of a type approved by the Director, either generally or in relation to a class of aircraft or the particular aircraft, and shall identify the overhaul, repair, replacement, modification or maintenance to which the certificate relates, and shall include particulars of the work done; or
- (b) Certify in relation to any inspection required by the Director that the aircraft or the part thereof or its equipment, as the case may be, has been inspected in accordance with the requirements of the Director and that any consequential repair, replacement or modification has been carried out."

The terms "as required by the Director" or "approved by the Director" mentioned above should be interpreted as meaning in accordance with the instructions/ work order provided to you by HM Sultans Flight.
